VolunTeen Program Information

WHC's **VolunTeen** program is designed to give students the opportunity to volunteer in a hospital department and gain volunteer experience. Accepted students will be assigned to ONE WHC department for the duration of the program.

This program is seven weeks in length. An orientation will be held prior to the program for accepted teens and parents. **PLEASE** check your summer to schedule to make sure you will be available for six out of the seven weeks.

Application deadline is May 1!! Applications received after this date will be considered ONLY if sufficient placements are available.

VolunTeens:

Applicants will be accepted based on:

- Approved application with parent or legal guardian signature
- Negative TB skin test (provided by WHC)
- Counselor/Teacher Recommendation Form
- Maintenance of a C+ or above GPA
- Age between 14 – 18 years
- Ability to give the program a consistent two hour shift for 6 out of the 7 weeks of the program
- Attendance at orientation (date TBA)
- Completion of HIPAA/Confidentiality training
